Our estate-grown Hillside Blossoms is grown on the hillside overlooking the Wisconsin River vineyard in Prairie du Sac. The varietals used, Lacrosse and St Pepin, are two American hybrids that can take the Wisconsin winters. Hillside Blossoms is a semi-dry vibrant blush with hints of tropical fruit, especially mango-like nuances.

 **Grape:** St Pepin and Lacrosse grapes custom-grown in the Lake Wisconsin Viticultural area, Prairie du Sac

 **Production Method:** cold fermentation, natural residual sweetness of 1.9% obtained by stopping fermentation and a sterile filtration to remove yeast, fermented like white wine

 **Aging:** none, bottled early spring

 **Sweetness:** semi-dry

 **Alcohol:** 10%

 **Serving Temperature:** 40° - 45°

 **Ageability:** 12-18 months
