Old Mill Red is a clean, light, crisp red made in a Beaujolais style. It is made from estate-grown Foch grapes. Uncrushed, cool fermentation within the berry brings out the delicate raspberry and cherry flavors. This wine is among a new trend of grapey ready-to-drink wines.

*Enjoy this wine at cool room temperature with white meats and sauces, hamburgers and grilled foods.*

 **Production Method:** carbonic maceration fermentation, Beaujolais method
