This is a great wine to enjoy all year long with friends and family. Serve chilled with appetizers, cheese and creek side picnics.

 **Grape:** 100% Pinot Grigio custom-grown in Washington state

 **Production Method:** cold fermentation, natural residual sweetness of .8% obtained by stopping fermentation and a sterile filtration to remove yeast


 **Aging:** none, bottled early spring

 **Sweetness:** nearly dry

 **Alcohol:** 10%

 **Serving Temperature:** 40° - 45°

 **Ageability:** 12-18 months
