Vidal is a crisp and refreshing semi-dry with aromas of pears and apricots that finishes with a wisp of sweetness. This wine has 1.6% natural sweetness and 10% alcohol and is very well balanced. Vidal continues to make us proud! So far in 2011, Vidal has earned four gold medals, plus most recently two Double Gold medals at international competitions in Los Angeles and Santa Rosa, California.
