






Waterfall Riesling

A light and gentle semi-dry Riesling, fermented like an Alsatian wine from northeastern France. It is made in a semi-dry style to bring out the richest flavor of the ripe grapes and has a hint of natural residual sweetness. Waterfall Riesling has intense fruit flavors reminiscent of apricots and pears. The bottles are a beautiful bright blue.

Enjoy chilled with pasta, seafood, oriental dishes, grilled foods and salads.

 **Grape:** 100% White Riesling custom-grown in Washington state

 **Production Method:** cold fermentation, natural residual sweetness of 1.9% obtained by stopping fermentation and a sterile filtration to remove yeast

 **Aging:** none, bottled early spring

 **Sweetness:** semi-dry

 **Alcohol:** 12%

 **Serving Temperature:** 40° - 45°

 **Ageability:** 12-18 months

 **History:** started making Waterfall Riesling in 2005
